A historic venue conveniently located in the centre of Aberdeen, the Society of Advocates offers a special environment for any event. There is the attractive main Library with room for up to 50 people, or the smaller Committee Room which seats 14 comfortably and is perfect for meetings.

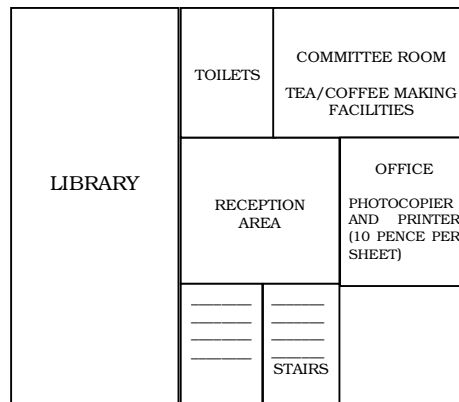
Facilities available include: wireless internet, projector and screen, laptop, flipcharts, crockery, cutlery and glasses – use of which are included in the cost. A member of staff will also be on hand to assist. All the furniture is movable in the library and it can be suitably arranged for dinners, seminars, wine tastings, birthday parties etc.

The entire cost for use of our facilities is £50 for the first hour, and £30 thereafter. Catering, if required, can be arranged to suit, at an additional cost and we are happy to recommend caterers. You are also free to provide your own catering or you're your preference of caterer. Tea/coffee and biscuits can be provided at 50p per person. Users are responsible to see that the fire regulation's permitted maximum of 50 is not exceeded and that the premises are left as they were found.

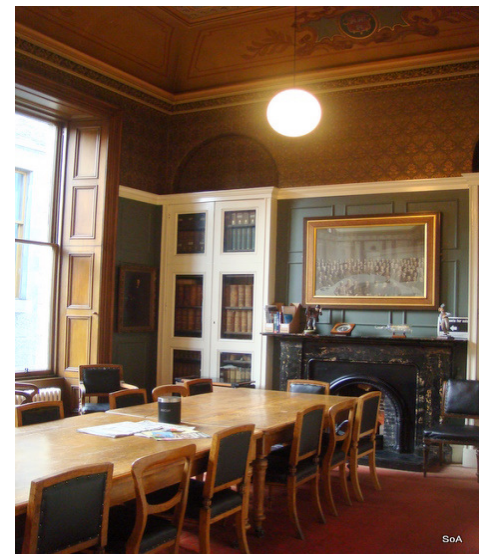
